



Edmonds Waterfront Center Solar Initiative

The Edmonds Waterfront Center is currently under construction. This 26,000 sf sustainable, LEED Gold building will be all-electric – zero emissions, with a 305 panel rooftop solar array. Globally, buildings generate nearly 40% of greenhouse gas emissions—even more in densely developed American cities.

Wanting to lead the sustainable building charge—rather than follow—the Board voted unanimously to switch (mid-construction) to an all-electric building and full solar buildout, which added \$500,000 to the cost of the building. The impact of this zero-carbon decision and investment will be amplified not only by the dramatically lessened carbon footprint of the building, but by inspiring others to look at their own lives and consider what bold actions they can take to mitigate climate change.
